We are looking for the following:

- Rare pieces of vintage tech
- Pieces of vintage tech with interesting histories
 - Pieces of vintage tech that were huge successes in their day—changed history
 - Pieces of vintage tech that were THE FIRST of something
 - Pieces of vintage tech that were unsuccessful at the time they were released, but today are collectible items
- WEIRD or WACKY pieces of tech. Items that look unique/strange and spark curiosity
