Flea Market Reservation Deadline

(Rev.1)

Due to the many new vendors wishing to reserve Flea Market spaces, as well as the many requests received from vendors to increase their number of spaces or to move to a different location in the Flea Market, there is a constant need to remain vigilant in controlling the spaces for all vendors. In an effort to serve both returning and new vendors, a deadline is in place, for returning vendors to renew their reservation for spaces they had reserved the previous year. The following details address the Flea Market Reservation Deadline and the process for returning vendors, to renew spaces they had reserved the previous year.

As a returning vendor to the Hamvention® Flea Market, you are a valued customer. For this reason, the Flea Market spaces that you occupied during the previous year will be held in your name, for renewal, for the upcoming (current) year's Hamvention® event. This allows returning vendors the first right of refusal of their previously held spaces. These spaces will remain on-hold until the end of day (midnight) on March 14th of the current event year, which provides ample time for anyone wishing to return to the Hamvention® to renew their previously occupied spaces. If however, the on-hold spaces are not renewed by midnight of March 14th, the Flea Market Committee reserves the right to make these non-renewed spaces available to any customers, on a first come, first served basis.

Additionally, if a returning vendor begins making a reservation request, prior to midnight of March 14th, they will have until midnight on March 21st to complete their request and make payment for their reservation. If they have not completed payment for their reservation prior to midnight on March 21st, the Flea Market Committee reserves the right to make the spaces in "unpaid reservations" available to any customers on a first-come, first-served basis.

If a vendor has had Flea Market spaces in the past, but does not return to the Hamvention® for the next consecutive year, those spaces will not continue to be held in that vendor's name for any future years and will thus be forfeited back into the pool of "available spaces".
